

Viewing the Patient Chart



Course Overview

When a patient is selected and displayed in the Current Patient window, you can access an overview of their health. The Patient's Chart displays allergies, problems, prescriptions, past medical history, lab results, and current orders.

This guide explains how to open and navigate a patient's chart, beginning from the Active Patients button.

Use This Guide When

- Viewing a patient's comprehensive electronic health chart
- Adding, modifying, or stopping active allergies or medical problems
- Discontinuing or adjusting active patient prescriptions

What You'll Be Able to Do

- Open a patient's chart and collapse navigation panels for maximum screen space
- Add, Edit, Stop or Reactivate diagnoses and patient allergies
- View future, active, and historical prescription records
- Document past medical history

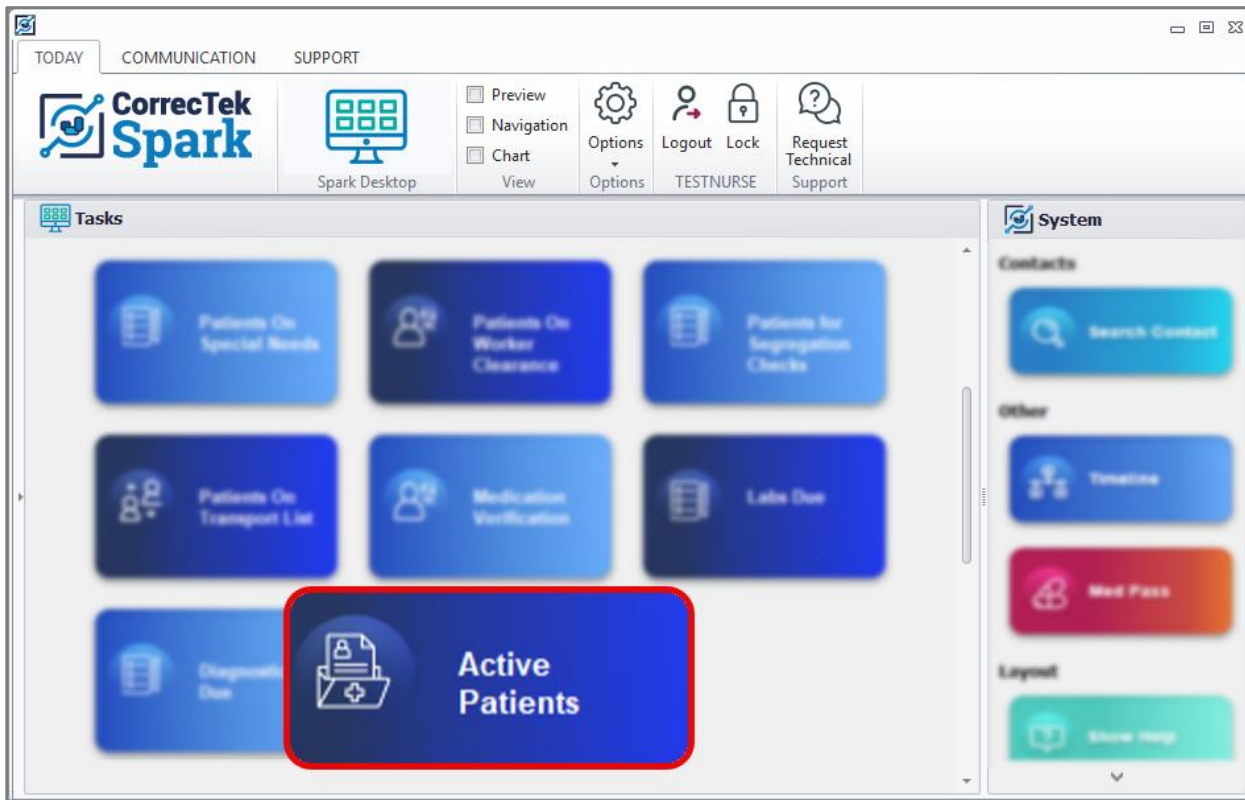

Spark Desktop

From the Spark desktop, click **Active Patients**.



Active Patients

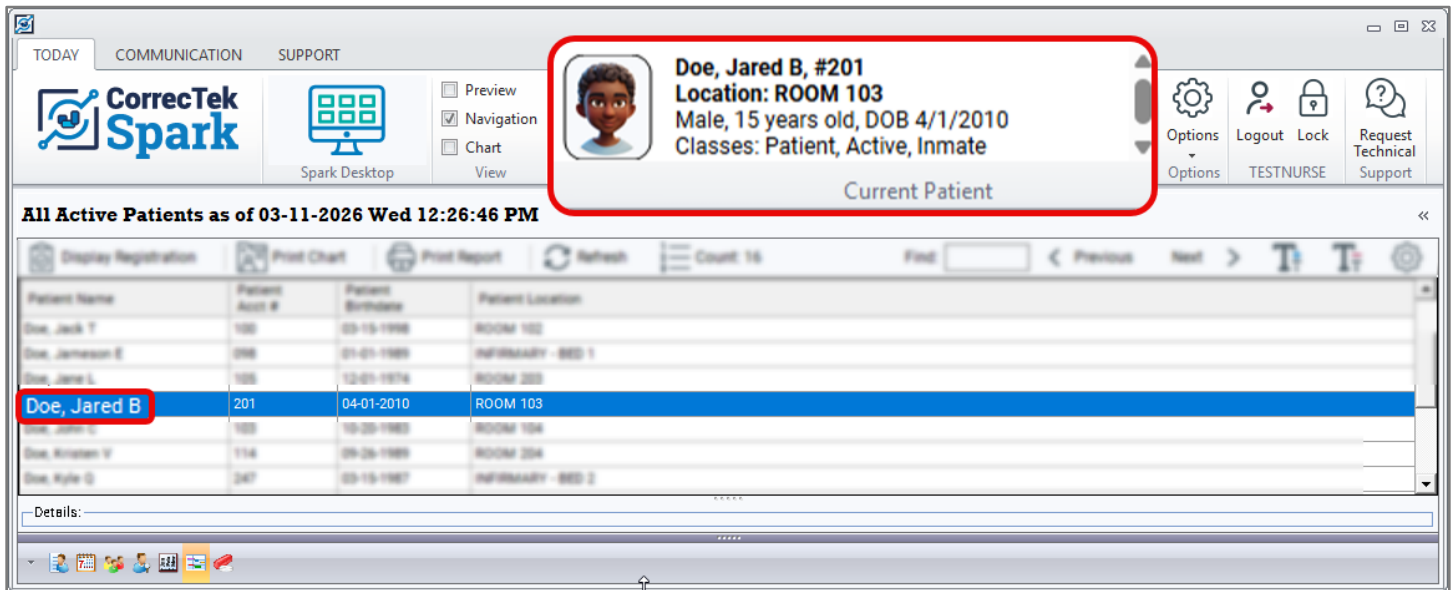
Locate the patient using the **Find** field. Click the patient's record to populate them into the **Current Patient** tracking window.

With the patient selected, click **Chart**. The patient's clinical file will display on the right side of your screen.

By default, the Overview tab opens, showing Current Problems, Active Prescriptions, Allergies and Past Medical History.

Click Navigation to collapse the patient search panel and expand your active viewing area.

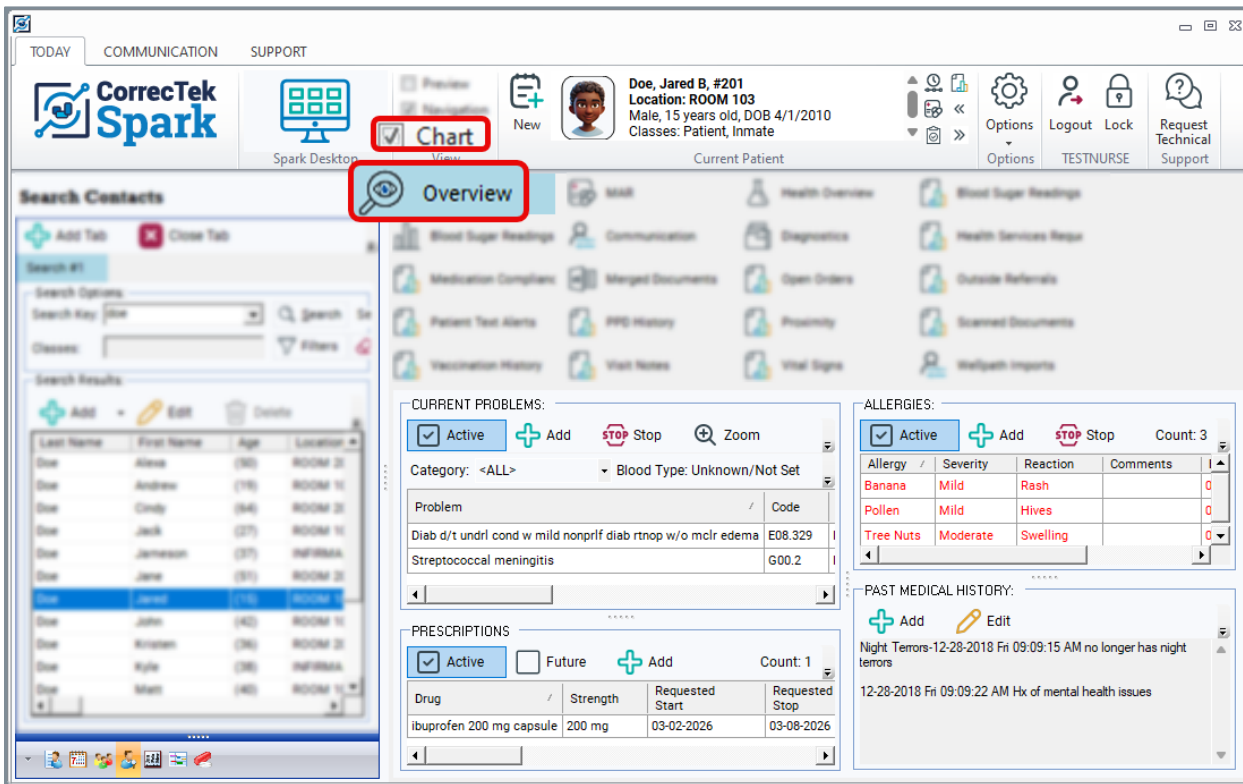
Chart

The patient **Chart** workspace acts as a central clinical repository for an individual's complete facility medical history. Use this workspace to audit a patient's real-time health status, reconcile clinical data, or modify their ongoing care plans.

Click **Chart**. The **Patient Chart** displays on the right.

The **Overview** tab opens by default, displaying the patient's Current Problems, Active Prescriptions, Allergies, and Past Medical History.

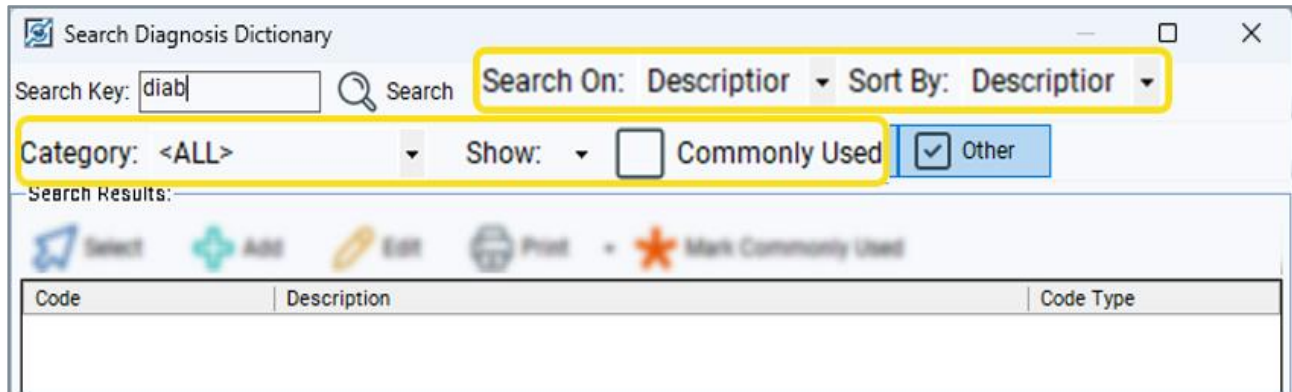
Narrow the Results (Optional)

You can narrow the search results using these options:

- **Category** – Filters diagnoses by type, such as Cardiovascular, Chronic, or DSM5
- **Search On** – Specifies whether to search by order Code or Description

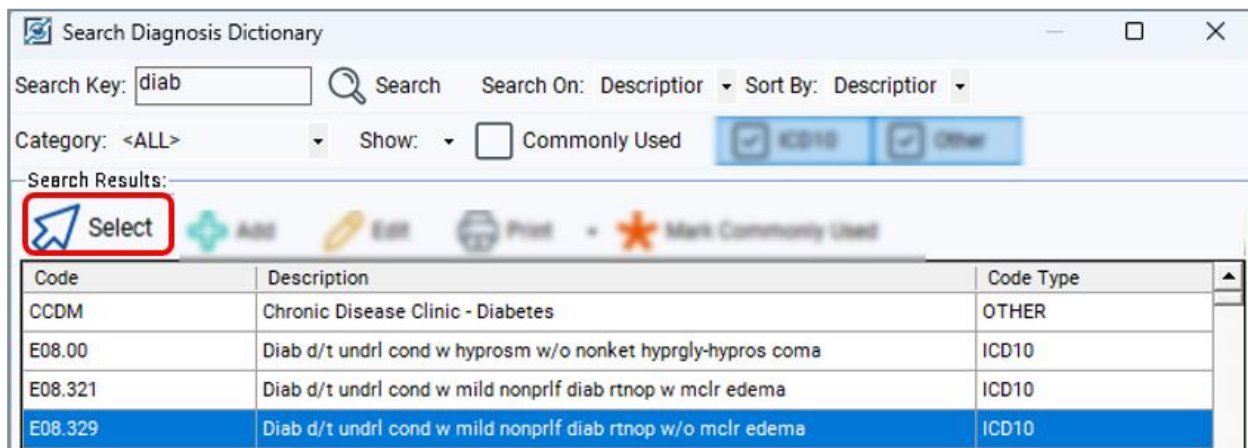
- **Sort By** – Changes how the results are sorted

Click to highlight the **problem** then click **Select** to return to the Add Problem window.



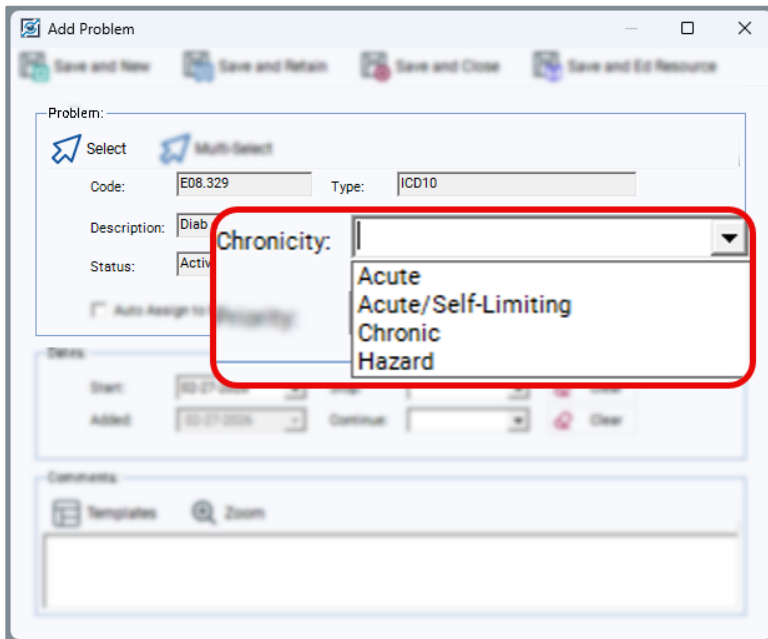

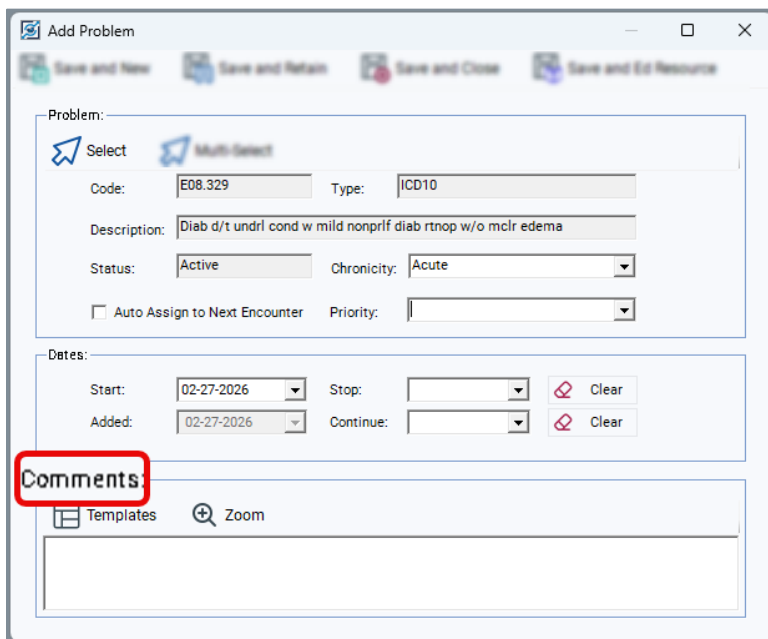

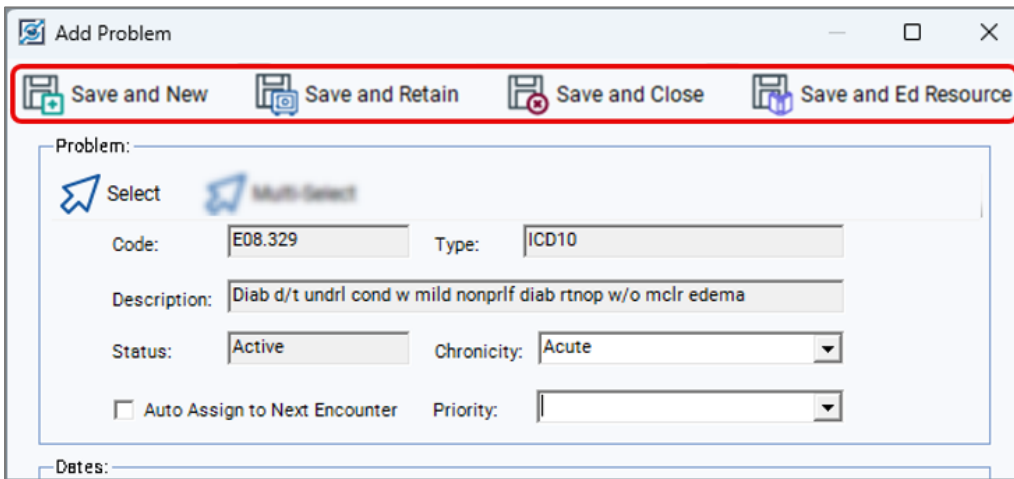

Viewing the Patient Chart



- **Save and New** – Saves the problem and clears the window for the next entry.
- **Save and Retain** – Saves the entry but keeps the active comments and chronicity for the next problem.
- **Save and Close** – Saves the current problem and returns you to the patient's chart.
- **Save and Ed Resources** – Saves the problem and links to Medline Plus to print an educational handout for the patient.

Tip: Before adding a new prescription, check the future prescriptions list to ensure it does not already exist. This is especially important when discontinuing a tapering dose, as additional future doses may also need to be discontinued.

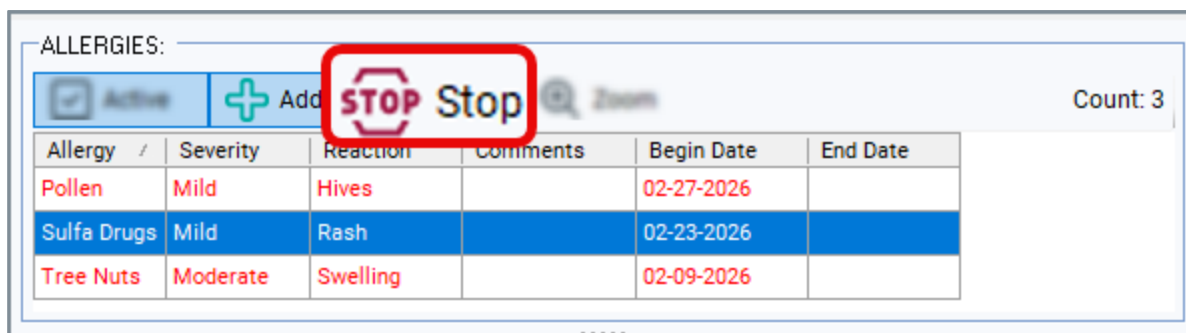
